- People were amazed at Jesus

### His Words

**Mark 6:2:** When the Sabbath came, he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. "Where did this man get *these things*?" they asked. "What's *this wisdom* that has been given him, that he even does miracles!"

**Luke 2:47:** Everyone who heard him was amazed at *his understanding and his answers*.

**Luke 4:22:** All spoke well of him and were amazed at *the gracious words* that came from his lips.

**John 7:15:** The Jews were amazed and asked, "How did this man get *such learning* without having studied?"

### His Works

**Luke 8:25:** In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."

**Matt 9:33:** And when the demon was driven out, the man who had been mute spoke. The crowd was amazed and said, "Nothing like this has ever been seen in Israel."

- They were filled with awe

**Luke 5:26:** Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were *filled with awe* and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."

**Luke 7:16:** They were all *filled with awe* and praised God. "A great prophet has appeared among us," they said. "God has come to help his people."

- They praised God

**Matt 15:31:** The people were amazed when they saw the mute speaking, the crippled made well, the lame walking and the blind seeing. And they *praised the God of Israel*.

**Mark 2:12:** He got up, took his mat and walked out in full view of them all. This amazed everyone and they *praised God*, saying, "We have never seen anything like this."

**Mark 5:20:** So the man went away and began to tell in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And all the people were amazed.

**Acts 13:12:** When the proconsul saw what had happened, he believed, for he was amazed at the teaching about the Lord.
