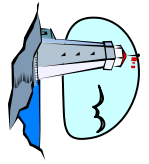

Building on Our Heritage

This is the appropriate time to review what **Building on Our Heritage** is about. This journey began with a need for additional Sunday School classrooms. We are also experiencing overflowing the sanctuary on Sunday mornings during summer months and on special occasions even though we have two services. The Kinlaw estate provided a substantial gift opening the opportunity for improvements. As a result of our church going through the "Thy Kingdom Come" program a Master Planning Committee was formed with the charge of determining the best use of our property. The Master Planning Committee along with architect Dale Gilliland developed a plan to maximize the use of our property which is a prime location in this city. The first phase was started with funds from the Kinlaw estate gift.

The **Building on Our Heritage** campaign was to fund The Master Plan which in total will be approximately \$10,000,000.00

First Phase:

- New Family Life Center (completed in October of 2007).
- Prepare entire project site and construct parking lots (completed in October of 2007).
- Convert existing fellowship hall into Sunday School Classrooms (completed).

Second Phase: Construct new sanctuary, educational wing, choir room wing.

Third Phase: Relocate and renovate administrative areas.

This construction was designed to provide us with necessary facilities to reach the un-churched in our area and grow God's kingdom.

We are thankful for those who have come before us and prepared the way for us to continue God's work. Our prayer is for His guidance as we continue to **Build on Our Heritage**.

Three years ago during May 2007 we enjoyed Faith Sunday when we made our commitments to give to our **Building on Our Heritage** capital stewardship program. The total commitments for that three year period were \$1,335,442. During those three years we have received \$985,292.68 (74%) toward that commitment. You are to be commended for your faithfulness in giving to this Master Plan. Thank you! You were asked for a three year commitment. That three year period is ending. Now, as we continue to make payments on our debt we need to ask for a NEW commitment. We are about to begin a new one year campaign based on the same techniques we used before. We intend to keep the same name "**Building on Our Heritage**" as we feel it is so very appropriate. We will be promoting this campaign during April with a Sunday school lesson on the 11th and sermons on the 11th and 18th. On April 25th we will have a special service, covered dish lunch on the grounds, and give you an opportunity to consider a new commitment to our Capital Stewardship Program.

The program promotes *informing* and *involving* the congregation with emphasis on *prayer* and *sacrifice* We would encourage you to begin praying about your participation. Ask for God's guidance! We should not give as we think we are able, but should commit to give as God leads us through prayer. Everyone's situation is different. The goal of this campaign is for everyone to make equal sacrifice not equal gifts.

Please pray for this program of sacrificial giving and ask God: "*What would You do through me to fulfill Your will for our church*".

We share the Easter story in many ways with the CDC children. We would like to share a recipe the children love to prepare.

He Is Risen Buns

Refrigerator butter biscuits—1 roll (Pillsbury or similar)
Large barshmallows—1 per biscuit
Melted butter
Sugar and cinnamon mixture—enough to cover biscuit

What we did: Each child gets a marshmallow (Jesus). The marshmallow is rolled in butter (anointing oil) and cinnamon sugar (anointing spices) and placed on a biscuit (tomb). The children then wrap and seal their marshmallow tightly in the biscuit. The tombs are baked according to package directions. When biscuits are cooled, each child opens their “tomb”...it is empty. Jesus is risen!! The marshmallow melts when baked leaving the biscuits hollow inside. Share John 20:6-9. Have a Blessed Easter! - The CDC Staff
