Items must fit in a gallon size zipper bag with zipper closed securely

- 1 black non-retractable pen (no wire clips, no other color ink)
- 1 writing tablet no larger than 5 1/2" x 8" (no wire bound notebooks, composition books, or post-it notes)
- 1 adult toothbrush (individually factory-sealed/ no multi-packs)
- 1 4oz to 6oz toothpaste (no travel size)
- 5 first-class #10 stamp-embossed envelopes (purchased at post office - no regular stamps, no other size envelopes)
- 2 rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, Breath Savers (NO Smarties, Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, TicTacs)
- 1 3.2oz to 6oz bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped/unboxed bars)
- 1 gallon size zipper bag (no other size bags accepted)

Please mark the items clearly for Prisoner Packets.

Please DO NOT INCLUDE: washcloths, toothbrush holders, floss, combs.
